Mapledurham House and Watermill and then at Caversham Heath Golf Club

Mapledurham Estate has the last working watermill on the Thames, which still produces flour for sale. In 2011 an Archimedes screw began generating electricity, using water from the Thames to operate a turbine. Ours is a private visit – the public opening is at 2pm.

The secluded Elizabethan house beside the Thames has been home to the recusant Blount family for four centuries. There are literary connections with Alexander Pope. Dr Ron Cookson is Chairman of the Mills Archive Trust, a registered charity responsible for the Mills Archive. He will talk about this Reading-based archive, the country's national repository for documents and images of windmills, watermills, and the people involved with them. Founded in 2002, it holds 2 million items, and is run by volunteers.

Mapledurham House (RG4 7TR) is signposted off the A4074 Oxford to Reading road.

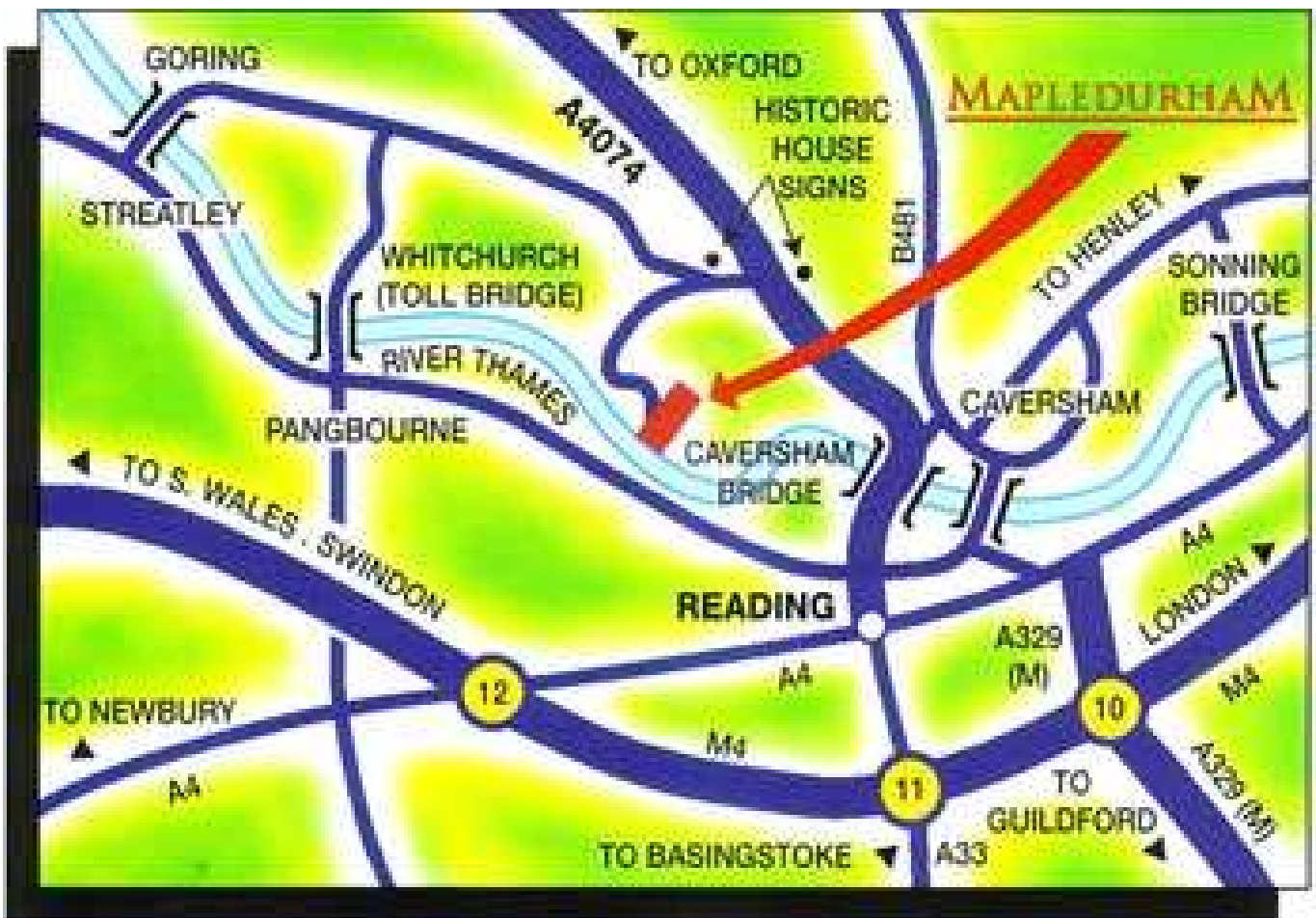

From Oxford, turn right along Sheepsway Lane and then bear left to Mapledurham House.

Note – although some sat nav systems suggest otherwise, there is no crossing over the Thames from Purley.
